The First Field Experience EDFE 200 is scheduled for 3 consecutive weeks, Monday – Thursday. The Education classes that you are registered for in the Fall term will not take place during this three week period except for EDEC 201 First Year Professional Seminar, and EDEC 262 Media, Technology and Education which are scheduled on Fridays. You should NOT register for any other course in the University other than those that are indicated on your Fall schedule as you cannot miss three weeks of class.

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NOTE: Students in the Science & Technology subject area profile or Math subject area profile must do certain courses in the Fall term in order to proceed to courses in the Winter term. Priority must be given to science or math courses. For example, students choosing Biology must do BIOL 200 (Molecular Biology) in the Fall term since this is a prerequisite for all other Biology courses.

Therefore, students in the Science & Technology subject area profile or Math subject area profile cannot take EDEC 201 First Year Professional Seminar / EDFE 200 First Field Experience in the first term due to the three week period spent in the schools. Courses EDEC 201 / EDFE 200 must be taken in Spring 2012. Registration will take place February 2012.

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## YEAR U3 (Students with Advanced Standing)
